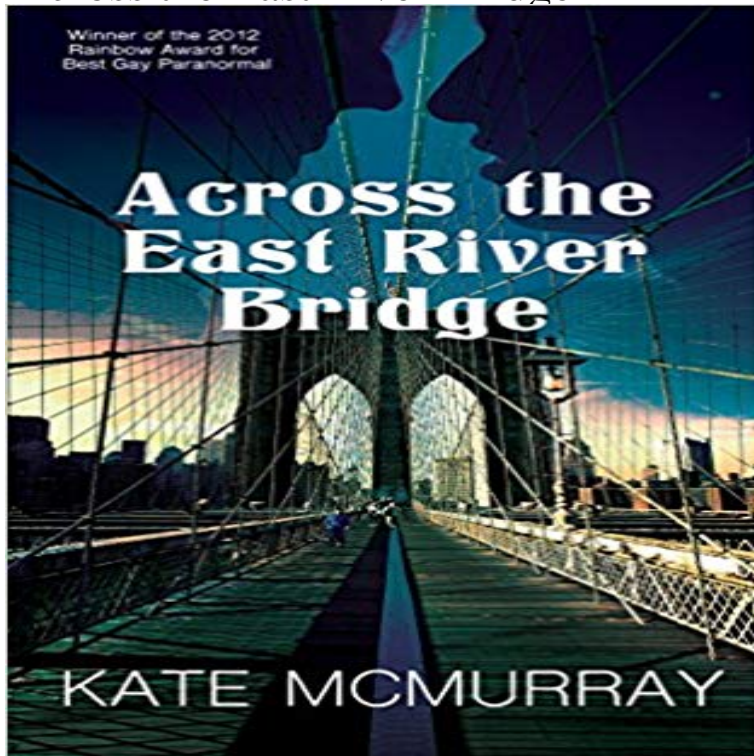


Across the East River Bridge

Troy is convinced the love between them is real, but he'll need to figure out how to get rid of the ghosts in order to prove it.
