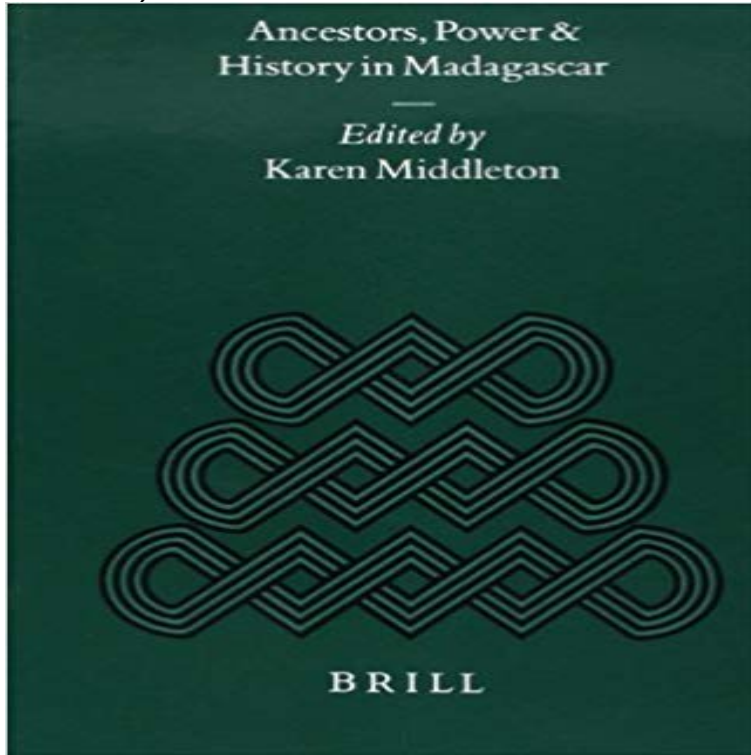


Ancestors, Power and History in Madagascar (Studies of Religion in Africa)
