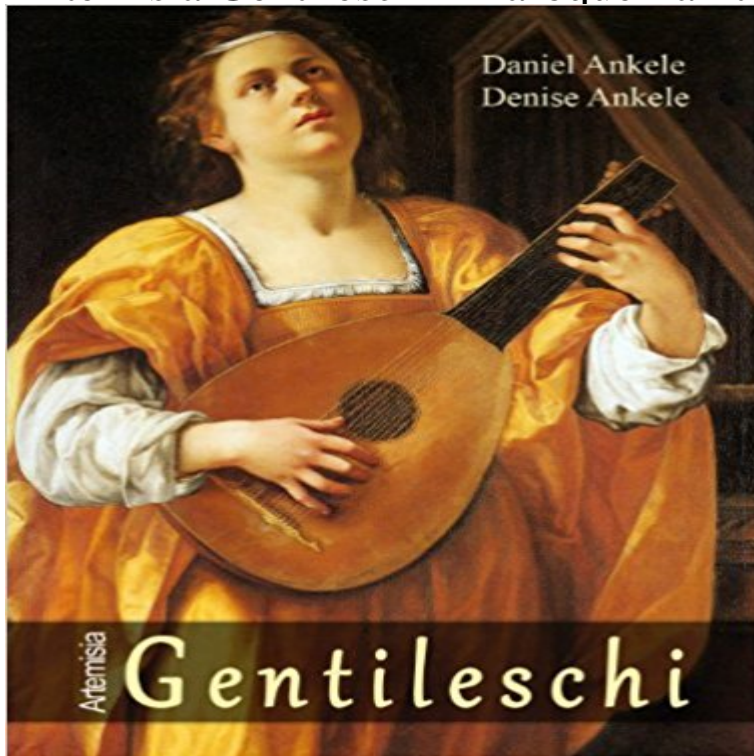


Artemisia Gentileschi - Baroque Paintings

Some of her paintings have been mistakenly attributed to her father, Orazio Gentileschi. Her paintings were heavily influenced by Caravaggio. Artemisia became a successful court painter in Florence, Italy. She was the first woman accepted into the Academia delle Arti del Disegno (Academy of the Arts of Drawing). She had five children; four sons and one daughter with her husband, Pierantonio Stiattesi. But only the daughter, Prudenzia, lived to adulthood. She also had another daughter (Father unknown) around 1627. She was friends with Galileo Galilei.
