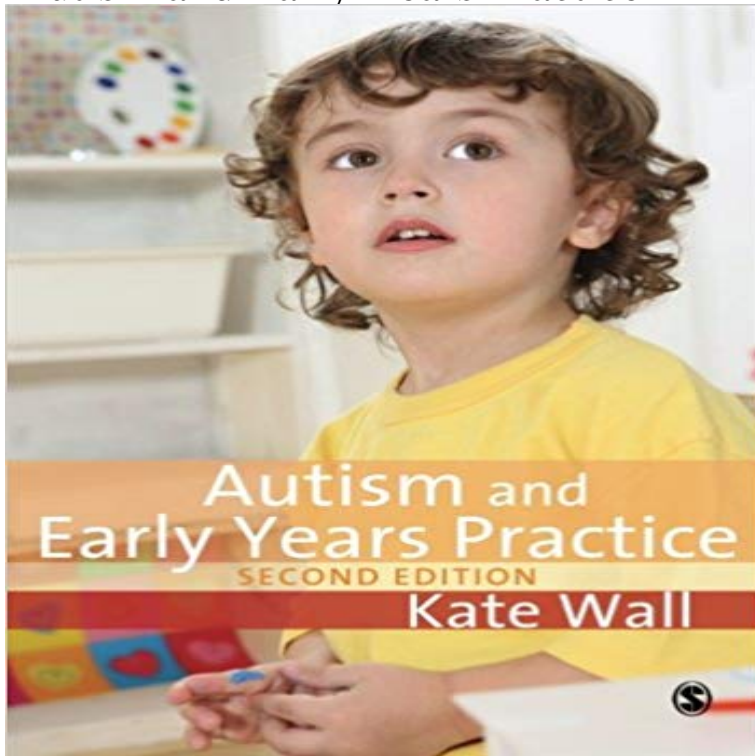


Autism and Early Years Practice
