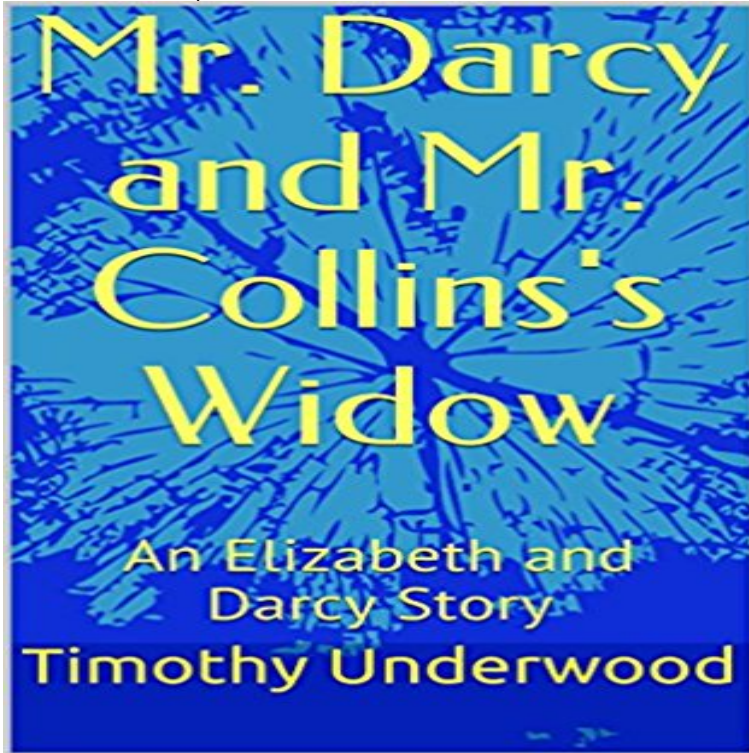


Mr. Darcy and Mr. Collins's Widow: An Elizabeth and Darcy Story
