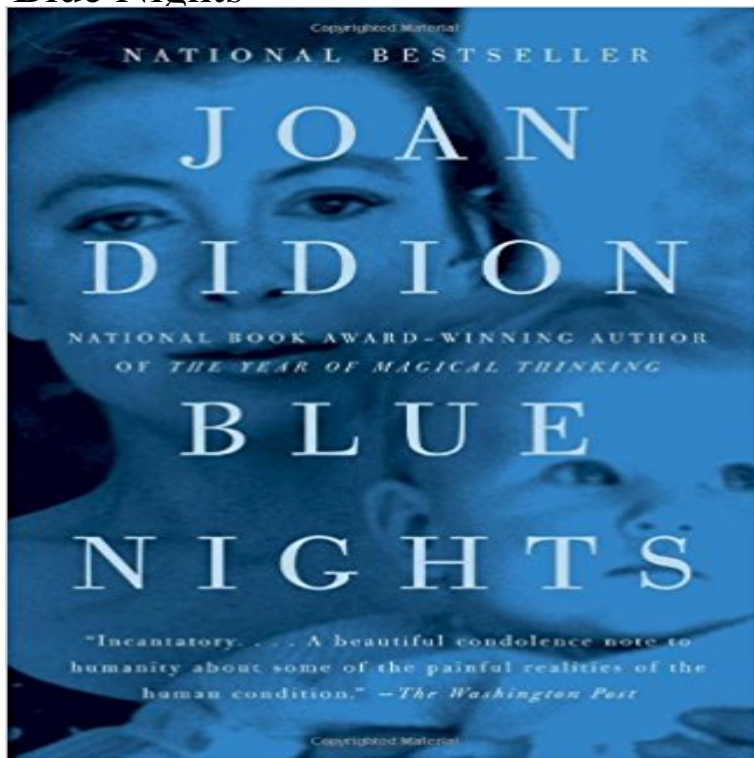


Blue Nights
