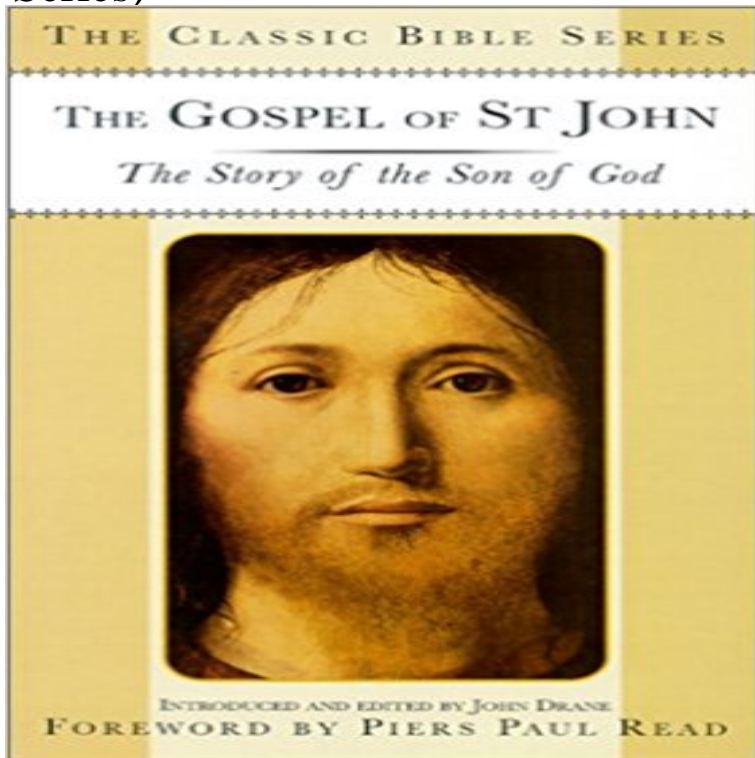


The Gospel of St. John: The Story of the Son of God (Classic Bible Series)
