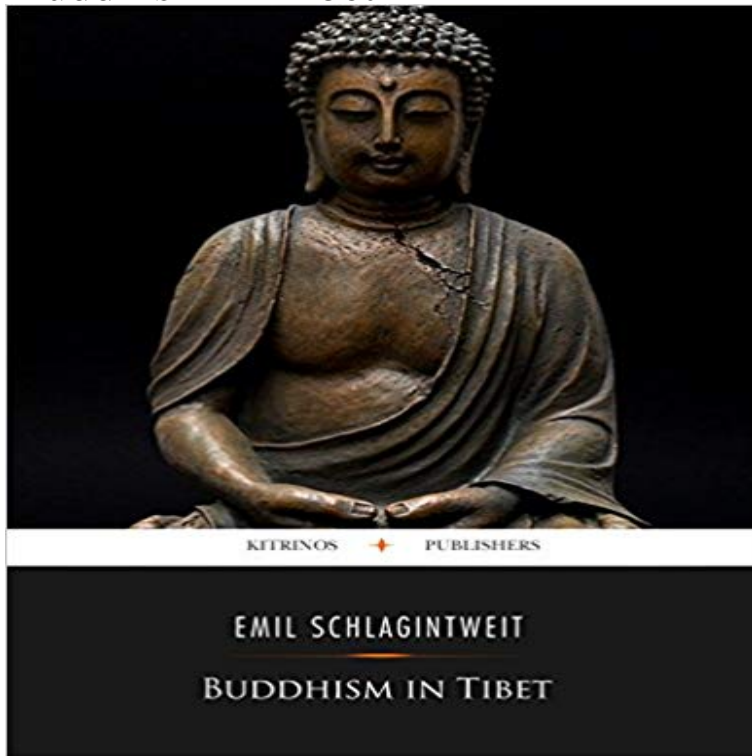


Buddhism In Tibet
