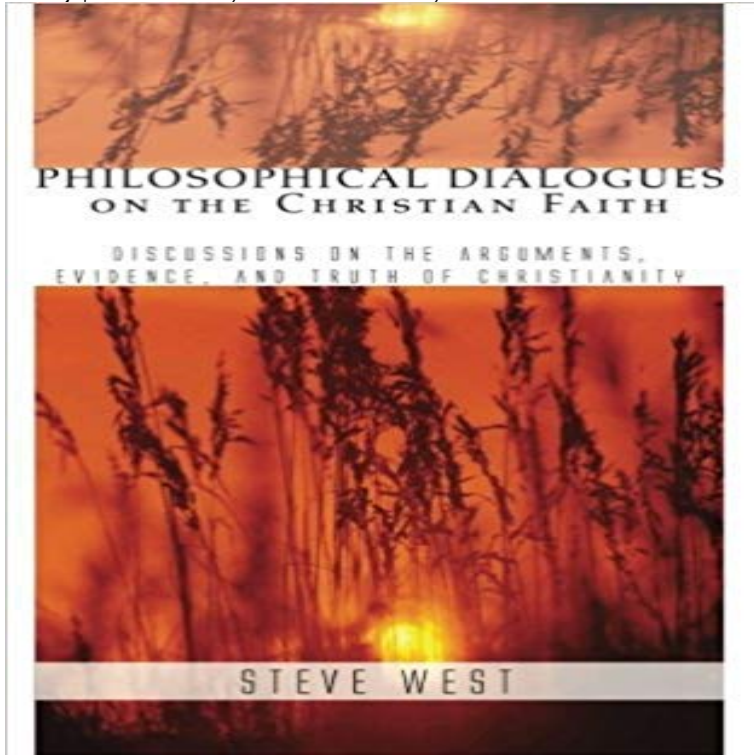


Philosophical Dialogues on the Christian Faith: Discussions on the Arguments, Evidence, and Truth of Christianity
