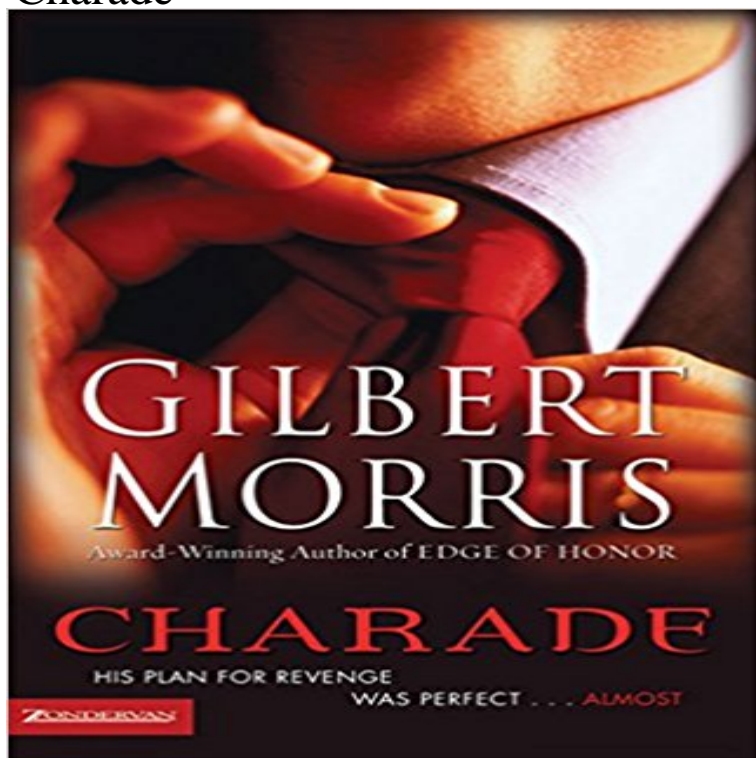


## Charade
