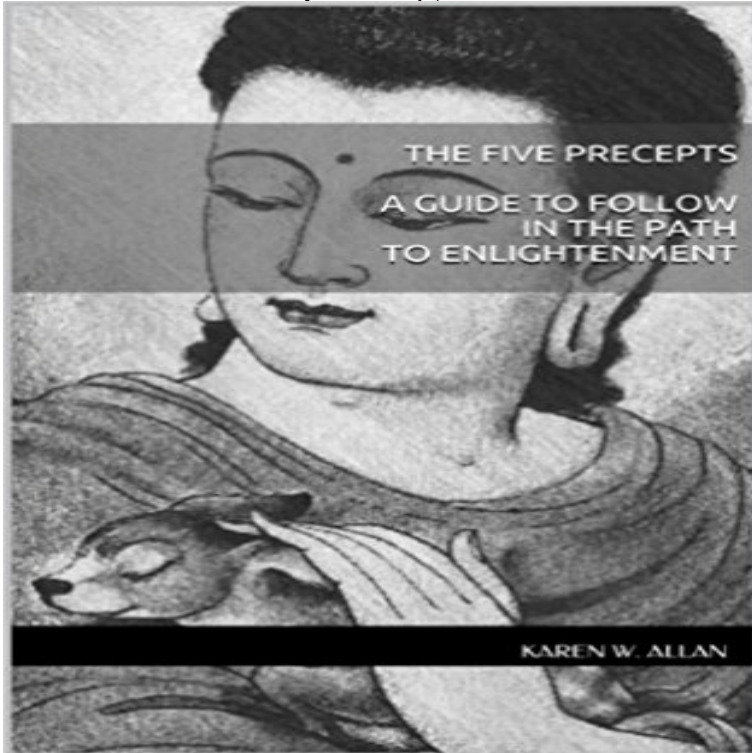


The Five Precepts A guide to follow in the Path to Enlightenment
