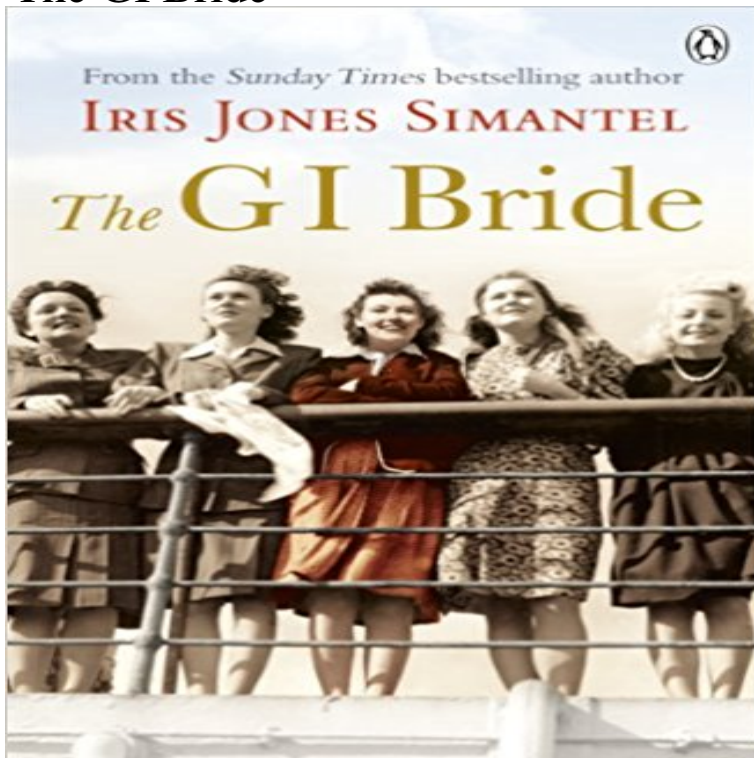


The GI Bride
