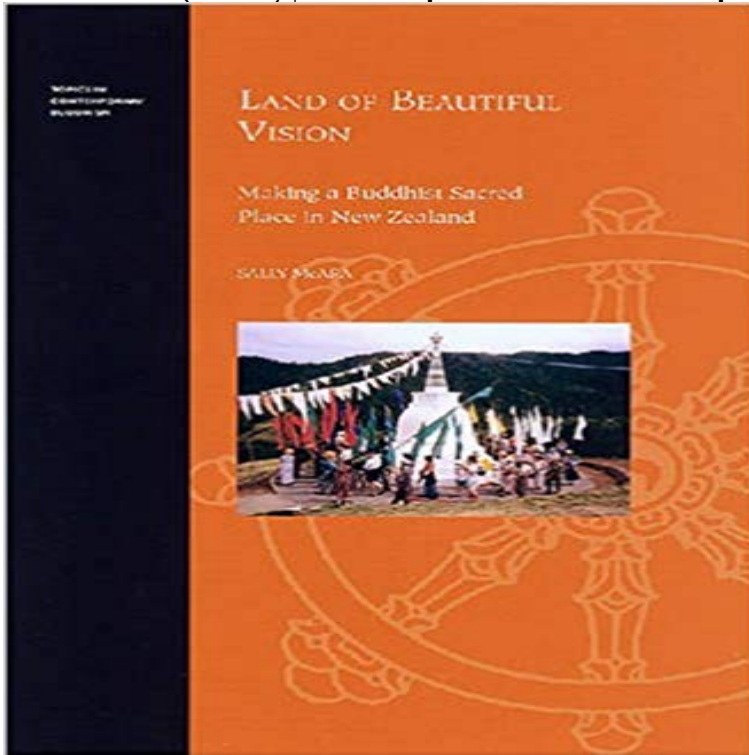


Land of Beautiful Vision: Making a Buddhist Sacred Place in New Zealand (Religion Topics in Contemporary Buddhism)
