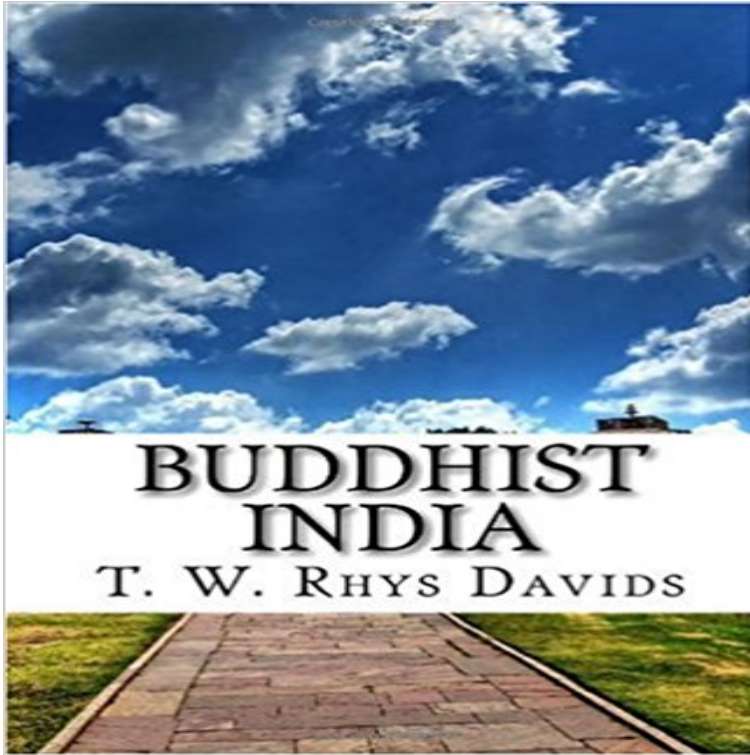


Buddhist India
