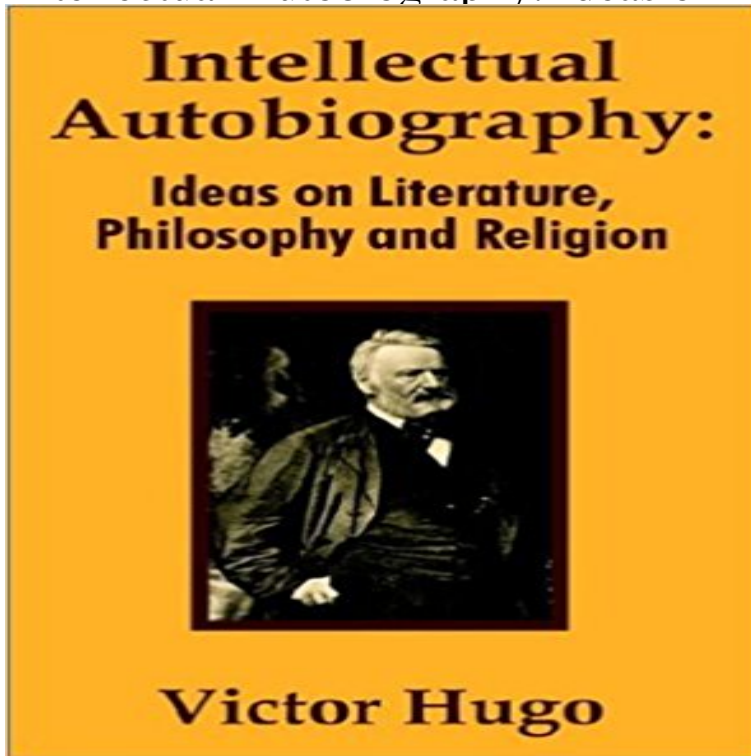


Intellectual Autobiography: Ideas on Literature, Philosophy and Religion
