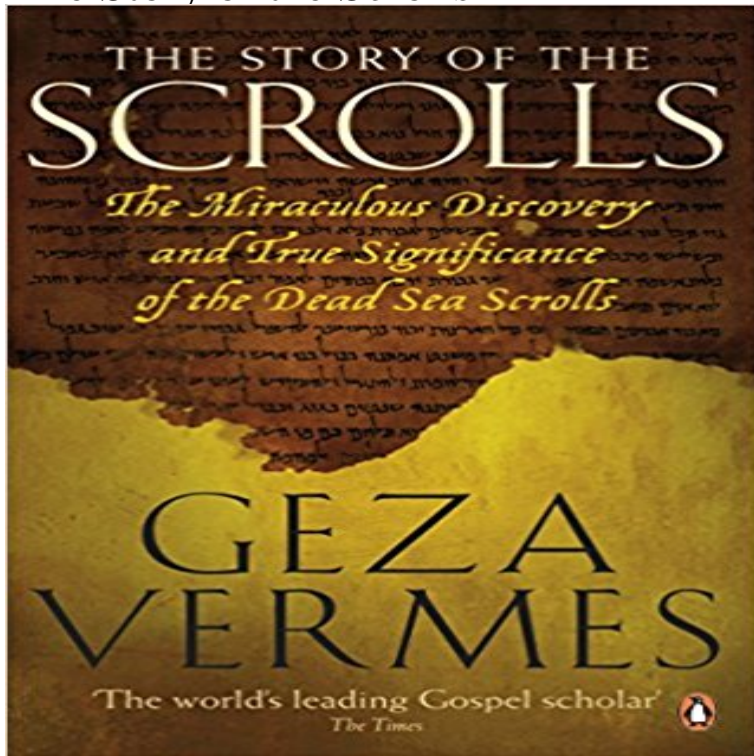


The Story of the Scrolls
