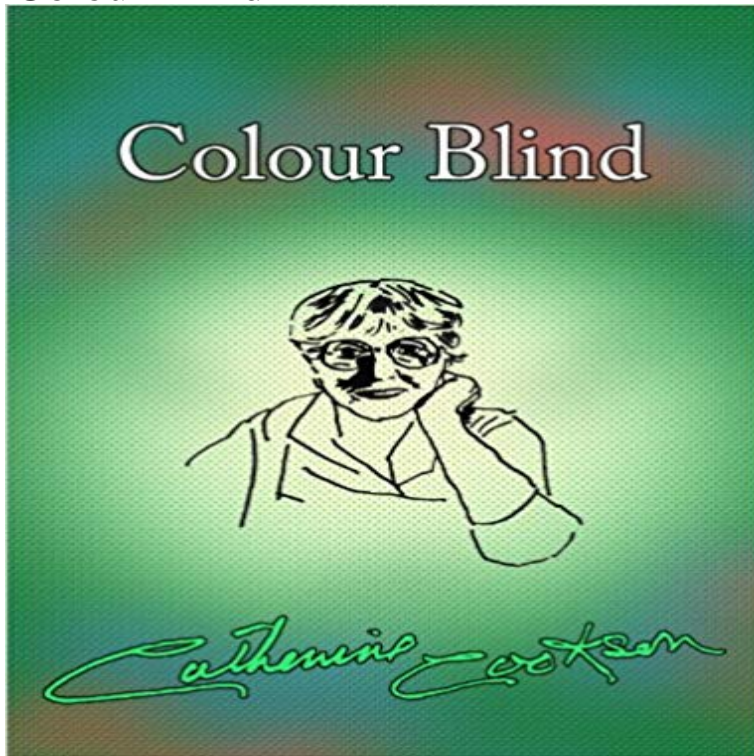


Colour Blind
