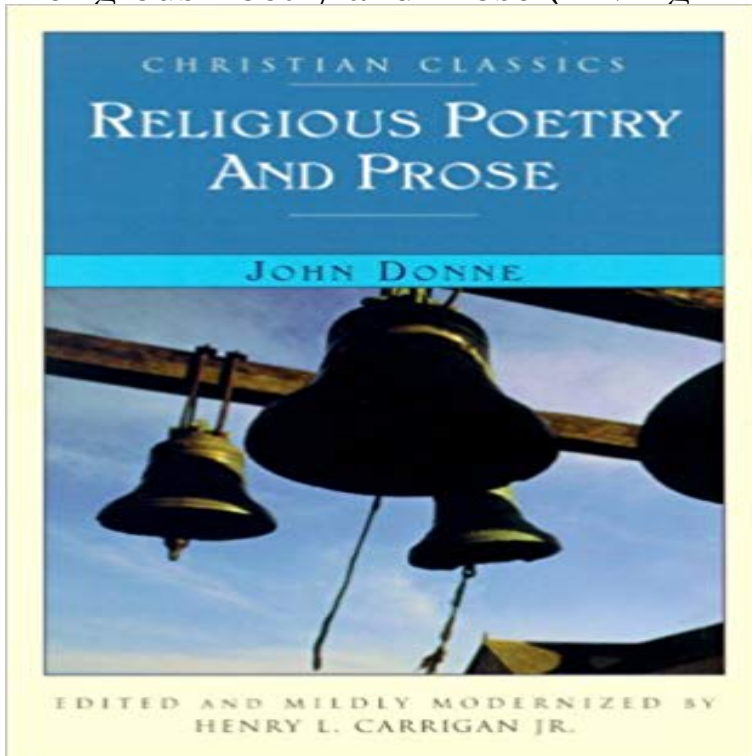


Religious Poetry and Prose (Living Library)

Ernest Hemingways For Whom the Bell Tolls takes its title from Donnes renowned Meditation 17, and the title of John Gunthers Death Be Not Proud is borrowed from one of Donnes holy sonnets. The poems, sermon selections, prayers, and devotions in this volume, mildly edited for the modern reader by Henry Carrigan, record the poets struggle to reconcile the passions of the flesh with the demands of the spirit, as well as the poets exalted love of Christ.
