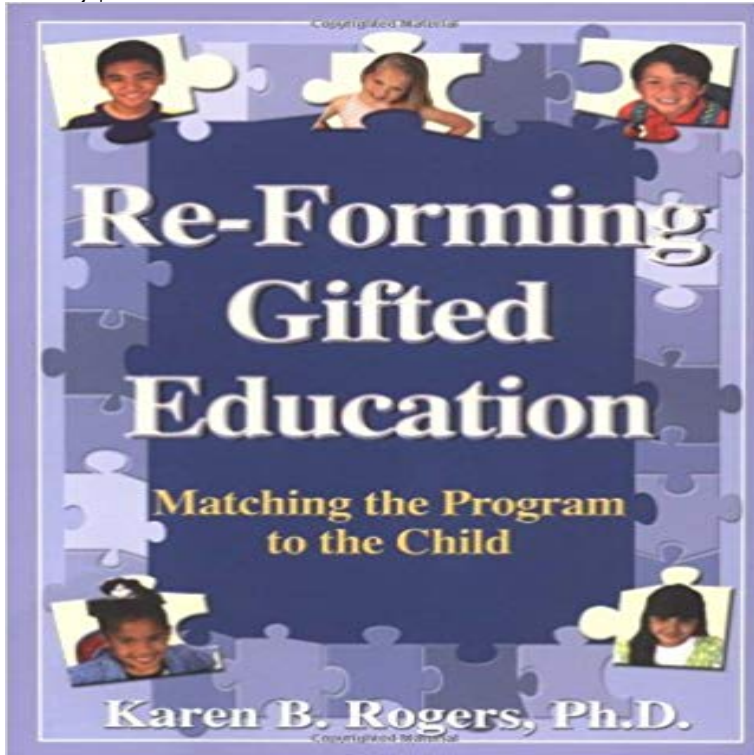


# Re-Forming Gifted Education: How Parents and Teachers Can Match the Program to the Child
