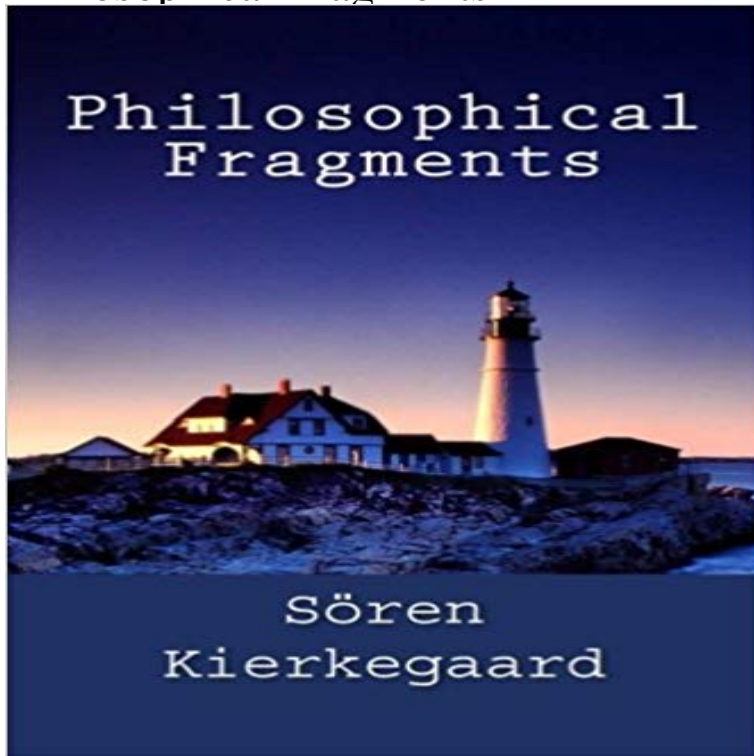


## Philosophical Fragments

If one were to read only two or three of Kierkegaard's works, this is unquestionably one of the ones to read. One cannot understand Kierkegaard's thought without reading this book, and along with its sequel represents the heart of what he was trying to achieve in what he called his Authorship. Through **PHILOSOPHICAL FRAGMENTS**, Kierkegaard purports to present the logic of Christianity.
