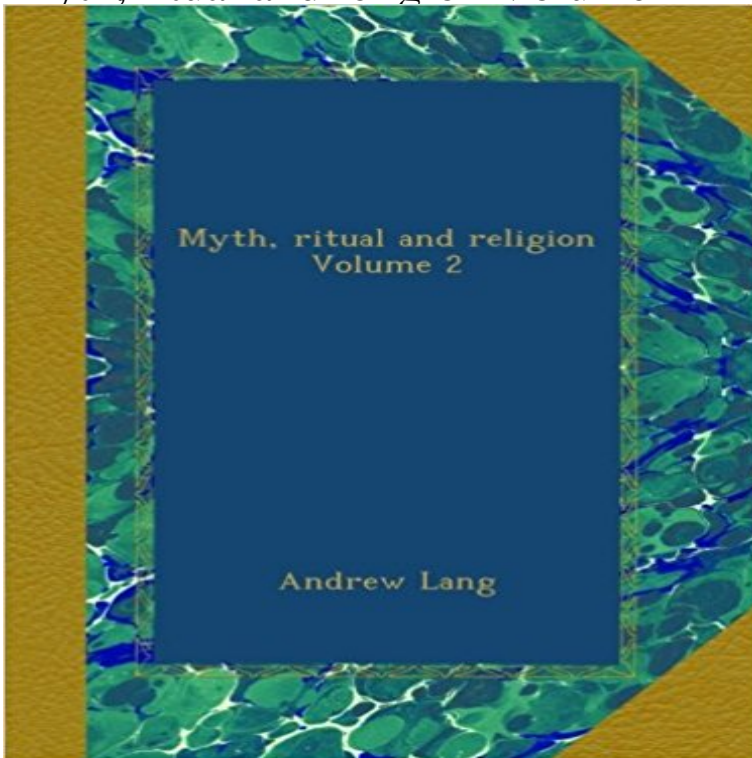


Myth, ritual and religion Volume 2
