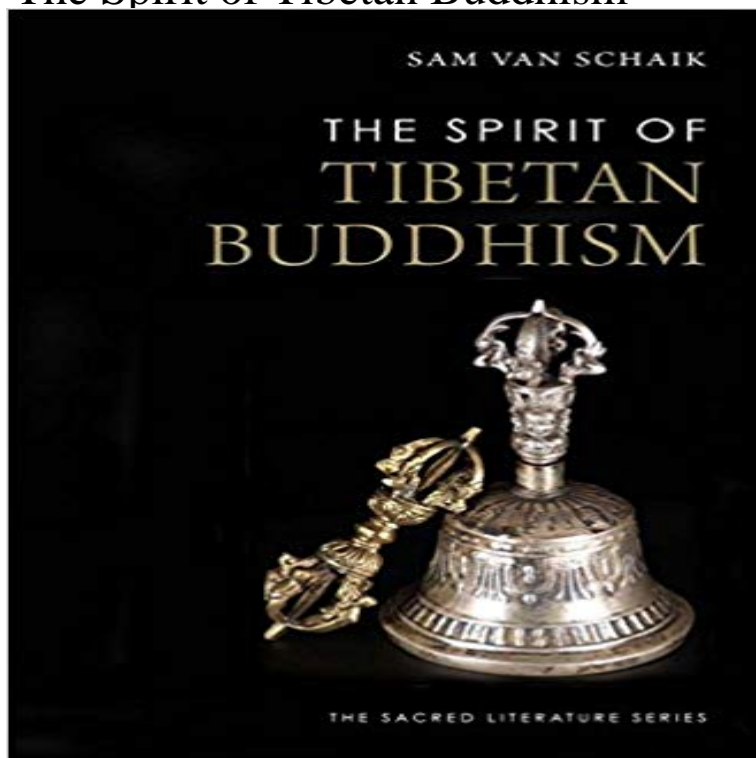


The Spirit of Tibetan Buddhism
