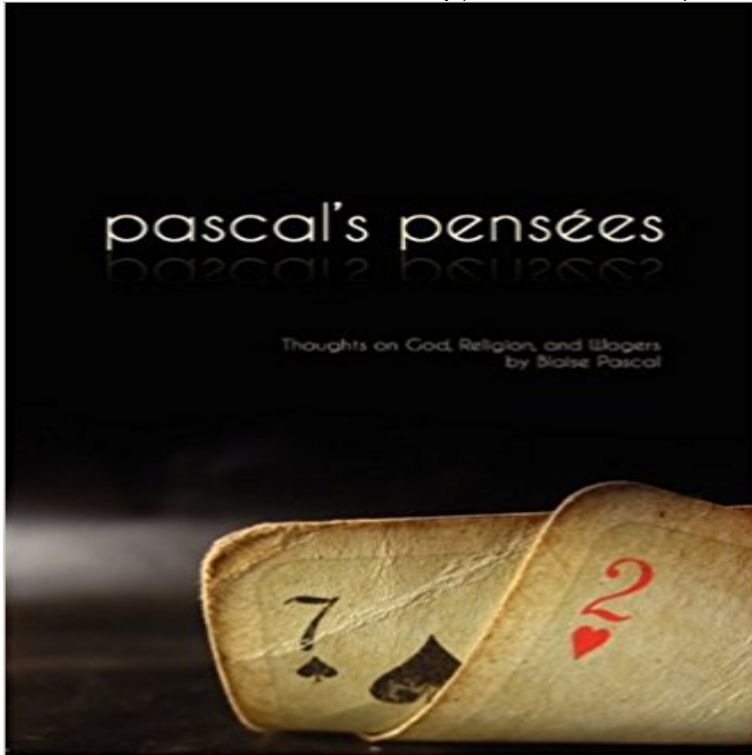


## Pascals Pensees: Thoughts on God, Religion, and Wagers
