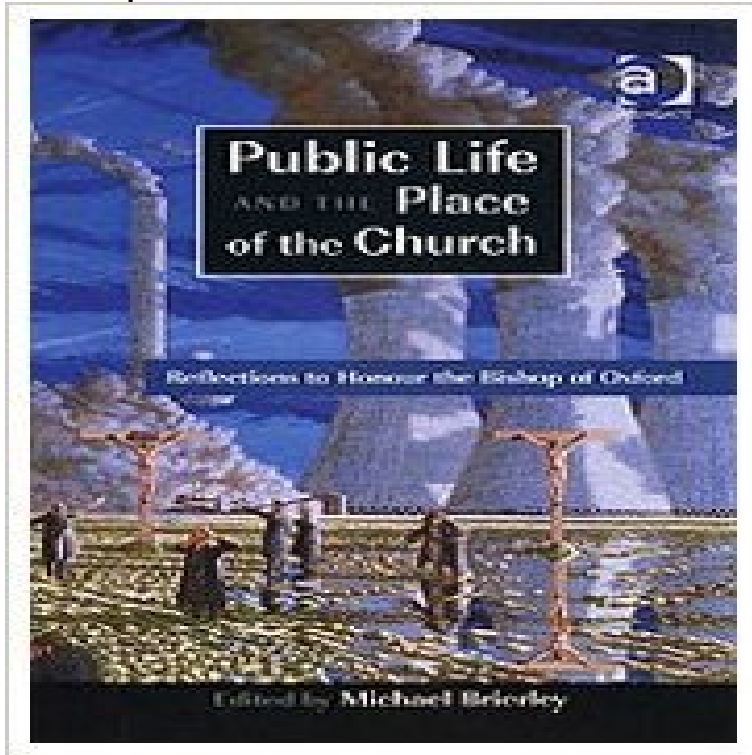


## Public Life And the Place of the Church: Reflections to Honour the Bishop of Oxford
