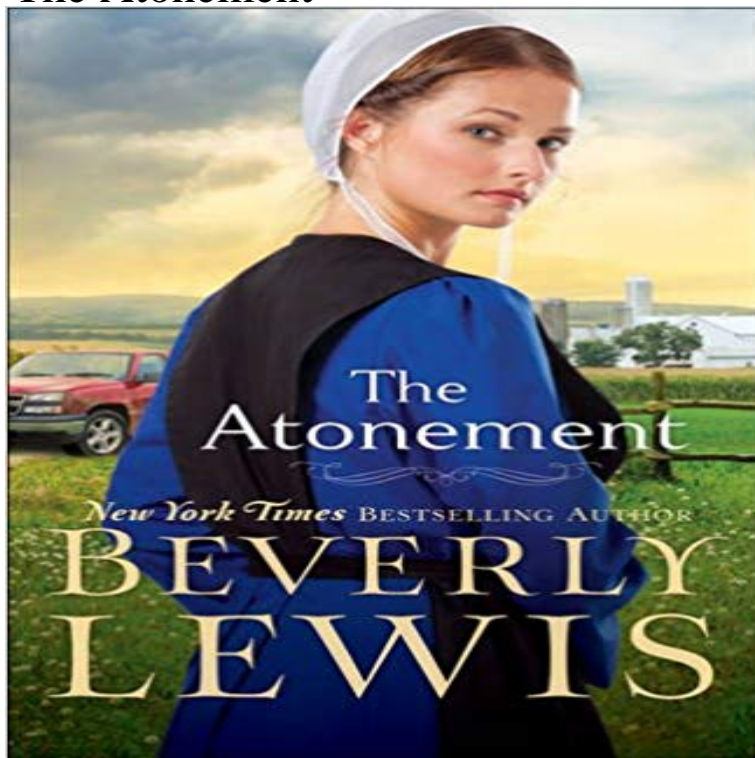


The Atonement
