
The Age of Reason (Classic Thought Series)



BECAUSE of this one work, Thomas Paines legacy has become, instead of that of one of the most celebrated, to that of one of the most infamous of the important figures of the American Revolution. In the minds of John Adams and many others, his THE AMERICAN CRISIS and COMMON SENSE were as important to American independence as the victories on the battlefield. But after the English-language THE publication of AGE REASONwritten for French а audiencePaine was unjustly branded an atheist and unworthy of public praise. fact, Thomas Paine was (as were other important revolutionary heroes) a deist; he believed in a supreme creator but took his proof from nature and reason. In the spirit of the French revolt against oppression from an aristocracy wholly supported by the established church, he chose to apply the test of reason to the prevailing interpretations of the Bible and to the authorship of the Scriptures. legacy is certainly less tarnished in modern times, but his work, including this one, needs to be read. Paine was a man of humble origin, but he was possessed of a brilliant mind; he was a first-rate scholar and a champion of reason and justice. Thomas Paine and THE AGE REASON....
