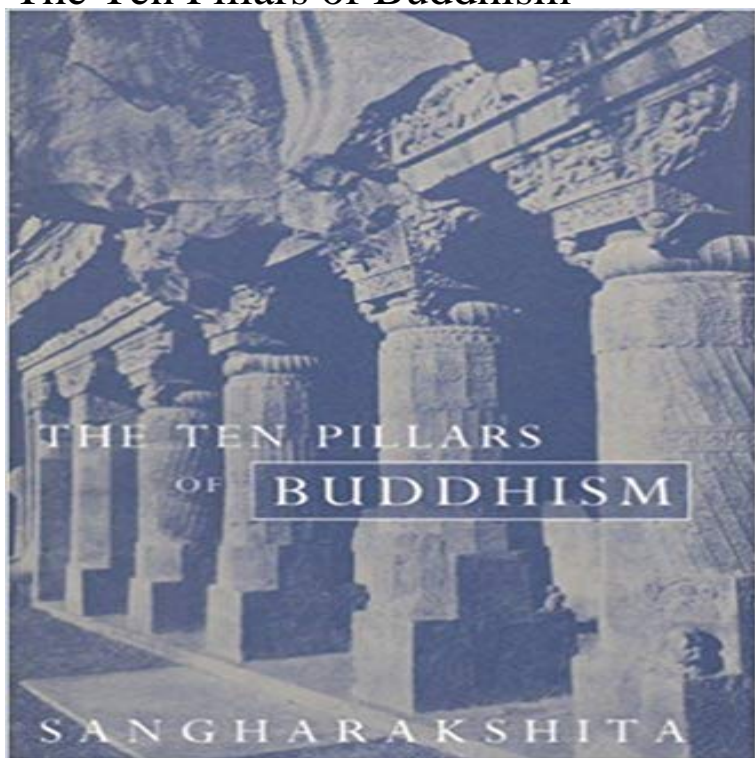


## The Ten Pillars of Buddhism
