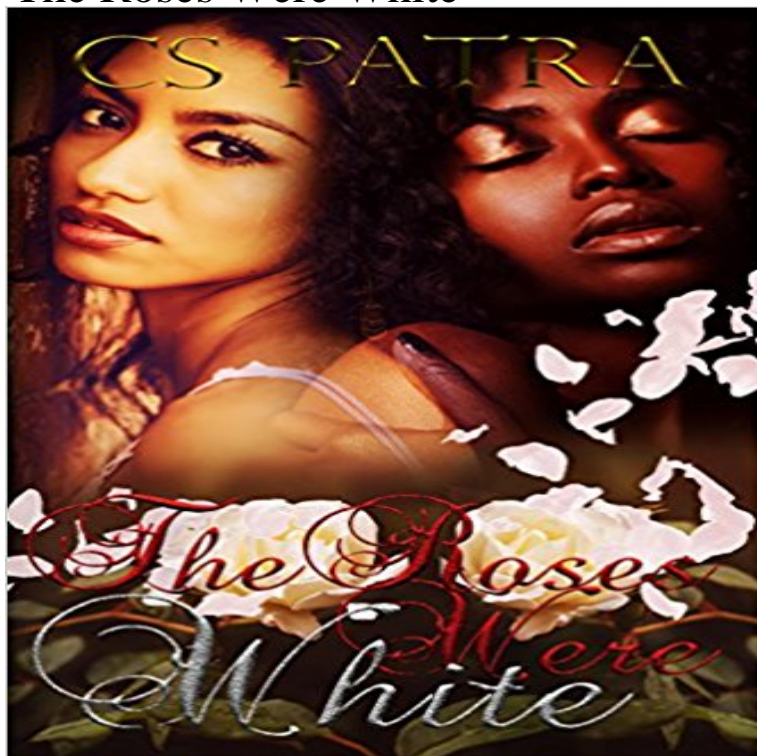


The Roses Were White
