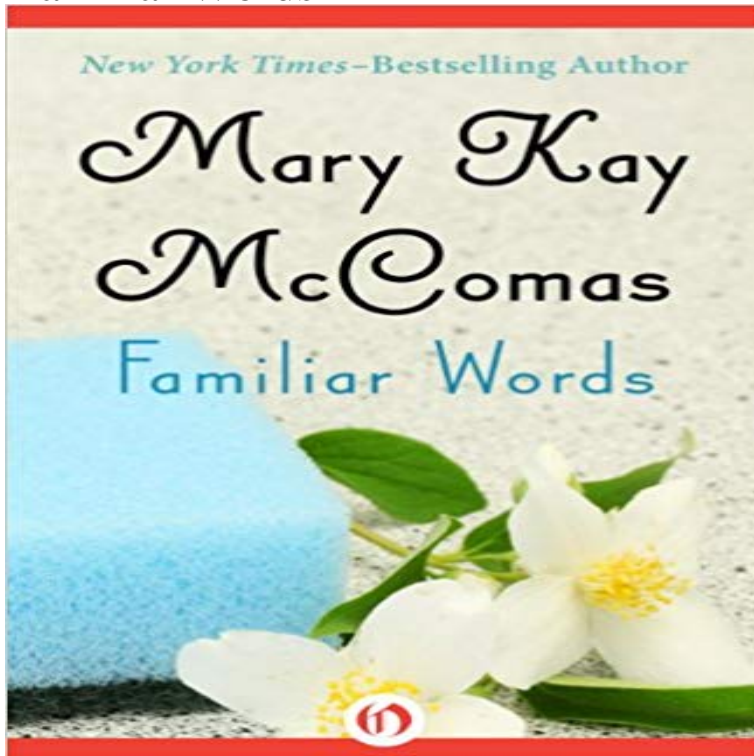


Familiar Words
