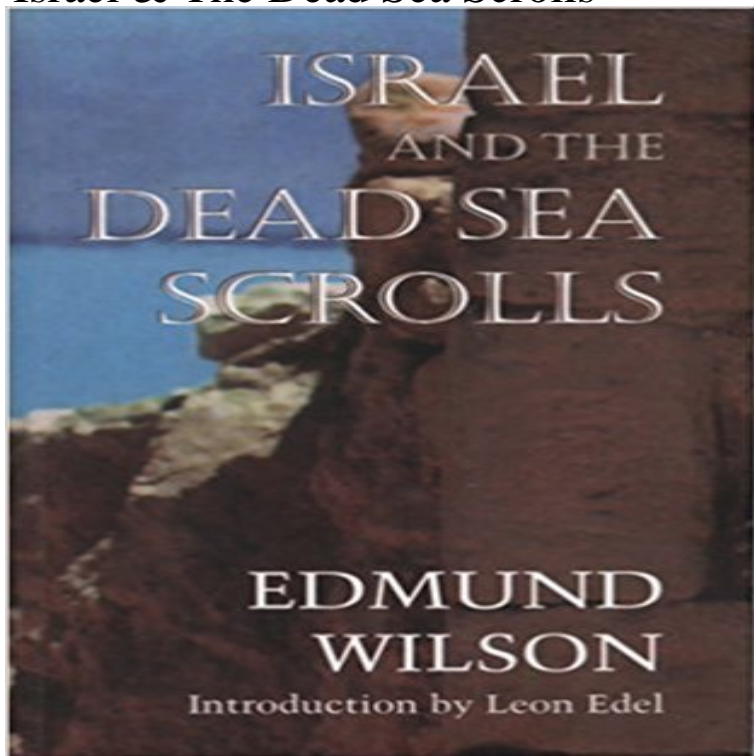


## Israel & The Dead Sea Scrolls
