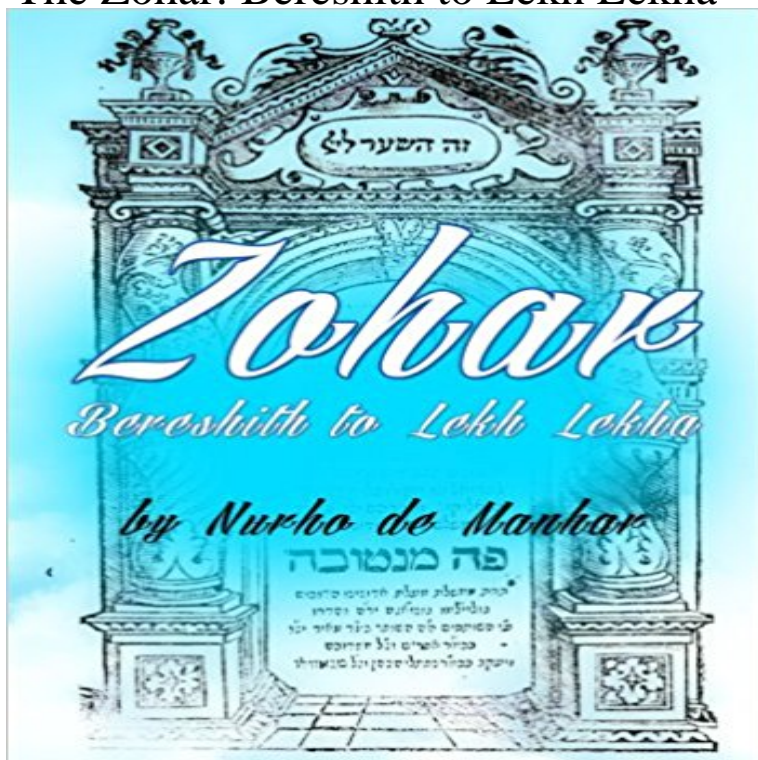


# The Zohar: Bereshith to Lekh Lekha
